## CERTIFICATE.

# Oath of Allegiance.

(Revised Statutes of Canada, 1906, Chapter 77, Section 13.)

I, Nathan Grief (18 years)  
formerly of Chemowitz in the Province  
of Bukovina in Austria  
and known there by the name of same name  
and now residing in the City of Montreal, District of Montreal P.Q., in Canada

Junk-dealer  
(Occupation)  
do sincerely promise and swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance  
to His Majesty King George V as lawful Sovereign of the United Kingdom  
of Great Britain and Ireland, and of the Dominion of Canada, dependent on  
and belonging to the said Kingdom, and that I will defend Him to the utmost  
of my power against all traitorous conspiracies, or attempts whatsoever which  
shall be made against His Person Crown and Dignity, and that I will do my ut-  
most endeavor to disclose and make known to His Majesty, His Heirs or Suc-  
cessors, all treasons or traitorous conspiracies and attempts which I shall know  
to be against Him or any of them; and all this I do swear without any equivoca-  
tion, mental evasion or secret reservation, So help me God.

giance as the whole will more fully appear by reference to the said oaths  
and the certificate of *Mayor* *Air Employee*  
of the City and District of Montreal, an officer duly authorized to take  
oaths under the Naturalization Act herewith fyled to form part hereof.

WHEREFORE your Petitioner prays that he be naturalized a Bri-  
tish Subject, and that all the rights and capacities of a natural born Bri-  
tish Subject be granted to him, and that a certificate of Naturalization,  
showing that your Petitioner has complied with all the requirements of  
law, be issued.

And your Petitioner as in duty bound will ever pray.
